Scissors and Markers or Crayons

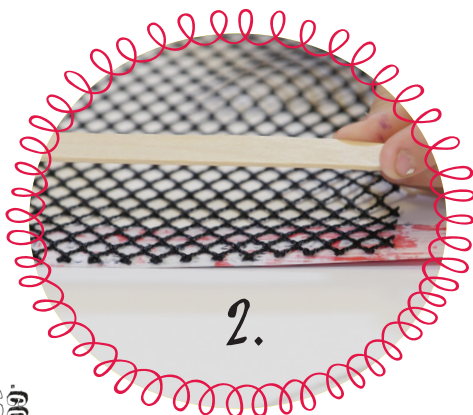
INCLUDED:

4 Peg Men, Fishing Net, Craft Sticks, Elastic Thread, and Fishers of Men Stickers



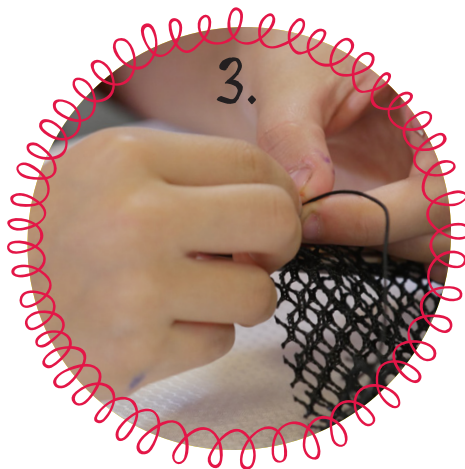
1. Color the Fishers of Men verse stickers.

2. Peel one sticker and place it sticky side up on a table. Put one short side of the net on the sticker. Put the craft stick on top. Fold the extra sticker over to secure the net to the stick. Repeat on the other side of the net with the other sticker and stick.



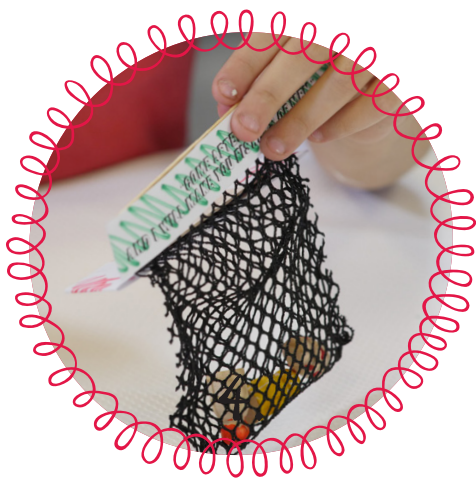

3. Use the elastic thread to tie and sew the net together on one side. Be careful not to stretch the thread when you tie it. Cut the thread and repeat on the other side.

4. Put your men in the fishers' of men net! They can represent the four disciples called by Jesus to be fishers of men in Matthew's gospel: Simon Peter, Andrew, James, and John. Optional: color your men.

1. What does it mean to be a "Fisher of Men"?
2. Who are the four disciples called to be fishers of men in Matthew's gospel?
3. When Jesus calls, how quickly should you answer?

A
