- Matthew 3:17

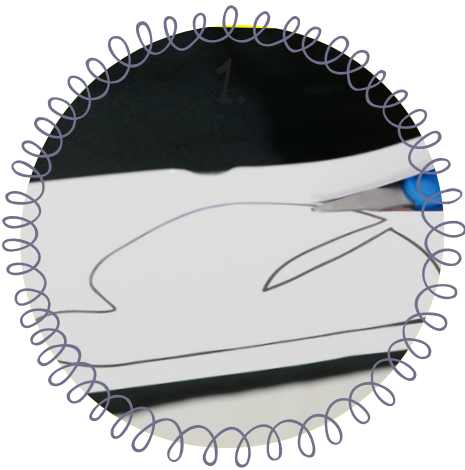


USE YOUR OWN:

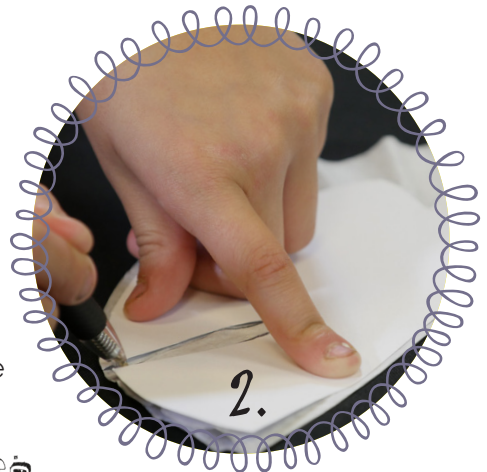
INCLUDED:

4 Coffee Filters, 1 Dove Template, Silver String, and 4 Tape Stickers



1. Cut out the dove template.

2. Fold a coffee filter in half. Lay the dove template on top of a coffee filter, with the bottom of the dove on the fold. Trace the lines around the tail, wings, and head of the dove. You can leave the ruffles on the ends of the wings!





3. Cut out the dove from the coffee filter, without cutting on the fold line at the bottom of the dove. Repeat for all the coffee filters.

4. Use the tape stickers to tape the doves to the silver string. Hang the string up and think about the Holy Spirit when you see the doves move in the wind!
