## HOLY WEEK



This week we travel with Jesus into Jerusalem and remember the suffering of Holy Week through the emptiness of Holy Saturday through the joy of the resurrection on Easter Sunday.

While many of us may be unable to participate in Mass in person this Holy Week, we can unite in prayer throughout the world.

Palm Sunday: Jesus is welcomed into Jerusalem.

Monday: Mary anoints Jesus' feet with oil.

Tuesday: Jesus warns of things to come, including his leaving and that Peter will betray Jesus before the cock crows three times.

Wednesday: Judas takes 30 pieces of silver to hand Jesus over.

Holy Thursday: The Last Supper is celebrated and Jesus institutes the Eucharist and washes the feet of the disciples. He prays in the garden and is arrested.

Good Friday: Jesus is crucified and dies on the cross.

Holy Saturday: All is still in the world as Jesus' body is in the tomb.

Easter Sunday: Jesus rises from the dead!
