## MATTHEW 25:31-46

Jesus said to his disciples: “When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, he will sit upon his glorious throne, and all the nations will be assembled before him. And he will separate them one from another, as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats. He will place the sheep on his right and the goats on his left. Then the king will say to those on his right, ‘Come, you who are blessed by my Father. Inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world. For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, a stranger and you welcomed me, naked and you clothed me, ill and you cared for me, in prison and you visited me.’ Then the righteous will answer him and say, ‘Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you drink? When did we see you a stranger and welcome you, or naked and clothe you? When did we see you ill or in prison, and visit you?’ And the king will say to them in reply, ‘Amen, I say to you, whatever you did for one of the least brothers of mine, you did for me.’ Then he will say to those on his left, ‘Depart from me, you accursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels. For I was hungry and you gave me no food, I was thirsty and you gave me no drink, a stranger and you gave me no welcome, naked and you gave me no clothing, ill and in prison, and you did not care for me.’ Then they will answer and say, ‘Lord, when did we see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or ill or in prison, and not minister to your needs?’ He will answer them, ‘Amen, I say to you, what you did not do for one of these least ones, you did not do for me.’ And these will go off to eternal punishment, but the righteous to eternal life.”

give to someone in need and to remember what Christ called us to do. Open the box by pushing the box open and pushing down on the inside of the box.

2. Decorate the outside of the box with smiley face stickers and any other drawings. This helps us remember to love others and to bring joy to them and to remember Christ sees how we treat the "least ones."

3. Fill the box with the first aid supplies for the sick, socks for those without clothing, and a granola bar for the hungry. You can also add a water bottle or any other packaged foods.

4. Keep the box in your family's car. When you see someone in need, an adult can help you give the box to them. Remember, only do this with an adult and to talk about today's readings.

**NOTE:** In this week's webisode, you'll see 3 years ago when we first made this craft. We focused on a first aid kit. Given the current world situation, we decided to not include items like gloves and make the box be a practical blessing for the homeless and follow more of the parts of Jesus' direction in the gospel.
