

# JANUARY 31: SCROLL FOURTH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME



## MARK 1:21-28

Then they came to Capernaum, and on the sabbath Jesus entered the synagogue and taught. The people were astonished at his teaching, for he taught them as one having authority and not as the scribes. In their synagogue was a man with an unclean spirit; he cried out, “What have you to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are—the Holy One of God!” Jesus rebuked him and said, “Quiet! Come out of him!” The unclean spirit convulsed him and with a loud cry came out of him. All were amazed and asked one another, “What is this? A new teaching with authority. He commands even the unclean spirits and they obey him.” His fame spread everywhere throughout the whole region of Galilee.

- While Jesus was in Capernaum, he taught on the Sabbath in the synagogue. The sabbath is the Holy Day of the week. The synagogue is also called a temple, a place of worship like a church. You could not get up and speak and teach without authority.


**THE MASS BOX**





4. Roll the scroll up from each side to the middle. Use the jute to tie the scroll closed. You can unroll the scroll and proclaim your favorite scripture!
