


FEBRUARY 28: TRANSCURED JESUS SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

INCLUDED:

Jesus templates
Glue dots and sticker
Vellum paper
Frame and cover
Plastic needle and thread



USE YOUR OWN:

Scissors
Optional: markers or crayons

MARK 9:2-10

Jesus took Peter, James, and John and led them up a high mountain apart by themselves. And he was transfigured before them, and his clothes became dazzling white, such as no fuller on earth could bleach them. Then Elijah appeared to them along with Moses, and they were conversing with Jesus. Then Peter said to Jesus in reply, "Rabbi, it is good that we are here! Let us make three tents: one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." He hardly knew what to say, they were so terrified. Then a cloud came, casting a shadow over them; from the cloud came a voice, "This is my beloved Son. Listen to him." Suddenly, looking around, they no longer saw anyone but Jesus alone with them.

As they were coming down from the mountain, he charged them not to relate what they had seen to anyone, except when the Son of Man had risen from the dead. So they kept the matter to themselves, questioning what rising from the dead meant.


1. Who did Jesus take up to the mountain?

2. Jesus showed the three apostles a glimpse of His divine nature in a transfiguration, where his clothes glowed bright white and God made it clear that Jesus was His son.



THE MASS BOX



1. We're making a framed piece of art that you can hang up in a window. You have two different sized Jesus cutouts to choose between! Cut out the size you like; smaller for more rays, larger for more Jesus.

2. Optional: color in Jesus. Then put 2 glue dots on the back and put him on the center of your vellum paper.



3. Tie a knot in the end of the gold thread and thread your needle. Using the needle, poke through the vellum paper to make rays.

4. When finished, tie the end and cut off the extra string. Put glue dots on the back of the frame and lay the vellum sheet on it to frame your artwork.



5. Optional: slide your finished framed artwork into the plastic cover to protect it. You can use the tape sticker to attach the extra string to the back to hang it up over a window!
