Planting pot
Drip tray
Seeds and soil
Cross stickers
Plant label stick

Water and sun
Scrap paper



JOHN 20:1-9

On the first day of the week, Mary of Magdala came to the tomb early in the morning, while it was still dark, and saw the stone removed from the tomb. So she ran and went to Simon Peter and to the other disciple whom Jesus loved, and told them, "They have taken the Lord from the tomb, and we don't know where they put him." So Peter and the other disciple went out and came to the tomb. They both ran, but the other disciple ran faster than Peter and arrived at the tomb first; he bent down and saw the burial cloths there, but did not go in. When Simon Peter arrived after him, he went into the tomb and saw the burial cloths there, and the cloth that had covered his head, not with the burial cloths but rolled up in a separate place. Then the other disciple also went in, the one who had arrived at the tomb first, and he saw and believed. For they did not yet understand the Scripture


1. What happened to the big stone in front of the tomb?
2. What did the disciples struggle to understand?

A.

1. The stone has been rolled away, and the tomb was empty.
2. They didn't understand yet that Jesus dying and rising from the dead was a part of the larger plan. They had to see to understand and believe.





2. Plant 4 or 5 forget-me-not seeds in your pot and cover them with a thin coating of soil. Sprinkle the rest outside to grow. Don't forget what Jesus has done for us!

1. Put scrap paper down on your work surface. Put most of the soil into your planter pot. Just as Jesus was in the tomb for 3 days, the flower seeds you are about to plant will take about 3 days to start sprouting and bring new growth!





3. Put one sticker on one side of the plant label stick. Put the other sticker matching on the other side so there is not sticky exposed. This reminds us that Jesus sacrificed on the cross for our sins out of love for us.

4. Put the cross marker into your pot, and the pot into the water tray. Water your plant with about 2 ounces of water. Keep the soil moist and put it in a sunny spot to grow! When the forget-me-nots are about 2-3 inches tall, plant the entire pot outside.
