## MARK 6:7-13




Jesus summoned the Twelve and began to send them out two by two and gave them authority over unclean spirits. He instructed them to take nothing for the journey but a walking stick—no food, no sack, no money in their belts. They were, however, to wear sandals but not a second tunic. He said to them, “Wherever you enter a house, stay there until you leave. Whatever place does not welcome you or listen to you, leave there and shake the dust off your feet in testimony against them.” So they went off and preached repentance. The Twelve drove out many demons, and they anointed with oil many who were sick and cured them.

1. Why do you think Jesus’ disciples, young men, would have needed walking sticks?
  2. What do you think would have happened to their sandals over time on such a mission?

- A**
1. The walking sticks let us know that they were going to journey far and traveling would not be easy. The walking stick would help them up mountains or in muddy areas or just give them extra support for long trips.
  2. Their sandals would have gotten worn over time. Their feet would be tired and dirty. Jesus and the Good News of the Gospel was worth all of that!


**THE MASS BOX**




1. Use the washi tape to decorate your walking stick.



2. Trace your feet on the cardboard from the Mass Box or any piece of cardboard. Put a dot with the marker at the spot between your big toe.



Cut out your traced foot. This is the sole of the flip flop.



3. Have a parent use the end of the scissors to poke a hole through the dot for the toe hole. Thread a folded pipe cleaner into the toe hole.

4. Decorate your sandals with washi tape and string your beads on the pipe cleaners.

Fold and tape down your pipe cleaners around the edges of the flipflop about two inches back to make the sandal straps.
