
1. Where do we see the Host?




1. Color your Chalice and Host template. Then, peel the backing off half of the contact paper, and lay it down with the sticky side up.

2. Lay the Host template on the contact paper.



3. Peel the backing off the rest of the contact paper, and fold it onto the Host template. Smooth the surfaces.



4. Cut the edges off the rest of the template and contact paper, as much or as little as you like.

5. Peel the back off of the self-adhesive magnet, and attach the magnet to the back of your Host template. Use this to hang it on your fridge, or another magnetic surface!
