## MARK 13:24-32



Jesus said to his disciples: “In those days after that tribulation the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light, and the stars will be falling from the sky, and the powers in the heavens will be shaken. “And then they will see ‘the Son of Man coming in the clouds’ with great power and glory, and then he will send out the angels and gather his elect from the four winds, from the end of the earth to the end of the sky.

“Learn a lesson from the fig tree. When its branch becomes tender and sprouts leaves, you know that summer is near. In the same way, when you see these things happening, know that he is near, at the gates. Amen, I say to you, this generation will not pass away until all these things have taken place. 1. What will the Son of Man do when He comes?

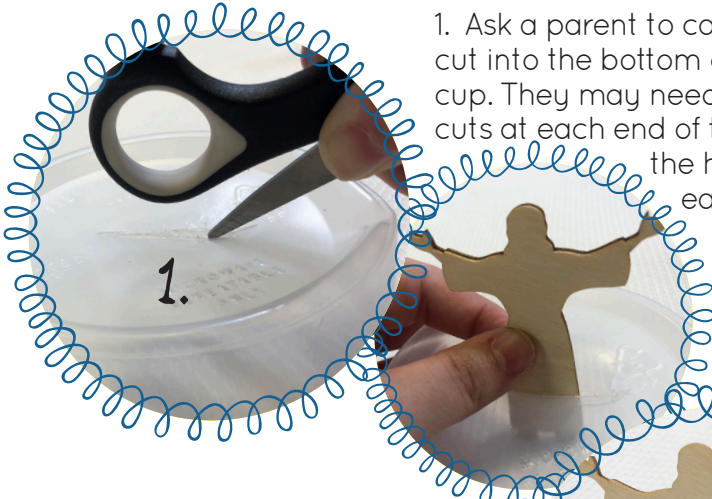
**A.**

1. We need not worry because Jesus is the Son of Man, who will come with great glory from Heaven and send angels to gather us.

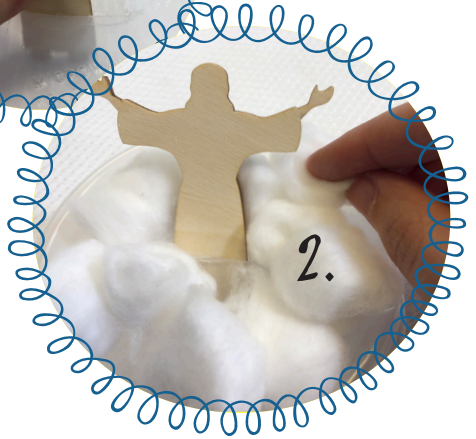

**THE MASS BOX**

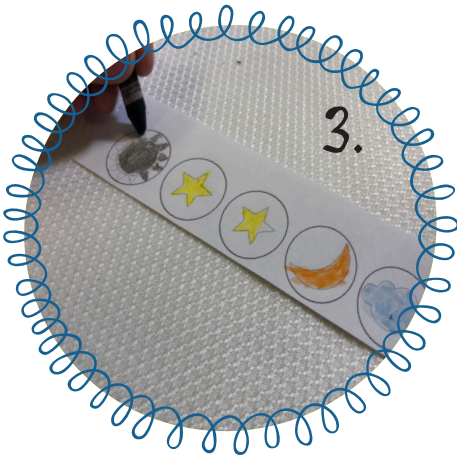
1. Ask a parent to carefully slice a cut into the bottom of the plastic cup. They may need to add smaller cuts at each end of this one, to make the hole bend more easily.



2. Slot the wooden Jesus cutout into the bottom of the cup. Then with the glue pen, put small dots of glue where you would like your clouds to go. Use the cotton balls to put clouds all around Jesus.



3. Using your crayons or markers, colour in your stickers. Remember that today's reading says that the sun will be darkened - so make sure to pick a dark colour for the sun sticker!



4. As the glue is drying beneath the cotton ball clouds, decorate the outer sides of the plastic cup with your stickers.
