JEREMIAH 1:4-5, 17-19



The word of the LORD came to me, saying:

1. Put the ultrasound image into the globe ornament. This represents the baby Mary, in her mother Anne's belly. Have you seen an ultrasound photo of you as a baby? Or, if you have siblings, an ultrasound photo of them?

2. Decorate using glitter glue. Make sure to work over your scrap paper to keep things clean! You can decorate on the image or the globe itself.



3. If you decorate inside the globe, leave it open for the glitter glue to dry. After it's dry, close the globe up. If you close the globe with wet glitter glue, it will not dry.

4. Thread the string through the little hole at the top of the globe. If needed, use the tape stickers along the closing of your globe to help secure it together. You can hang this as decoration in your room as a reminder that the Lord knows and loves you for exactly who you are - and did so before you were even born!
