LUKE 9:28B-36




Jesus took Peter, John, and James and went up the mountain to pray. While he was praying his face changed in appearance and his clothing became dazzling white. And behold, two men were conversing with him, Moses and Elijah, who appeared in glory and spoke of his exodus that he was going to accomplish in Jerusalem. Peter and his companions had been overcome by sleep, but becoming fully awake, they saw his glory and the two men standing with him. As they were about to part from him, Peter said to Jesus, "Master, it is good that we are here; let us make three tents, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." But he did not know what he was saying. While he was still speaking, a cloud came and cast a shadow over them, and they became frightened when they entered the cloud. Then from the cloud came a voice that said, "This is my chosen Son; listen to him." After the voice had spoken, Jesus was found alone. They fell silent and did not at that time tell anyone what they had seen.

What happened after the voice spoke?

Moses and Elijah were no longer with Jesus. Peter, James, and John were silent. They did not speak of this immediately.



1. Fold the sheet of cardstock into thirds, so that the picture and verse are facing out, but keep flat so that you can decorate.

With the glitter glue pen, make Jesus' clothes pretty and shiny to emphasise that they have been transfigured!


2. Use the cotton balls to make clouds around Jesus, Moses, and Elijah. You could even pull the cotton apart a little to make them more wispy.



You can also use any of your own craft supplies you may have at home to decorate further!

3. Using the folds you made in step 1, create your triangle so that your art is on one side, and verse is on the other.

4. Secure the open ends of the triangle together using the circle-shaped tape.



We can display this craft to help remind us of what God said to the disciples, "This is my chosen Son; listen to Him."
